## Territory Acknowledgement

We, the Hałtzaqv (Heiltsuk), have been here since the beginning of time. Archaeological evidence corroborates our núym (oral history and stories) for at least 14,000 years. Our amalgamated Hłtzaqv (Heiltsuk) territory includes 'Wúyalitšv, 'Qvúqvaýáitšv, wúíłitšv, 'Yísdaítšv, and ́ı́ı́is tribes. Bella Bella is located on the Bella Bella Indian Reserve #1, Wáglı́słá, located on Campbell Island, on British Columbia's Central Coast.

## Hiking Information

Hiking alone in the woods of Bella Bella, BC, Canada can be dangerous. The rugged terrain and dense foliage can make it easy to get lost, and encounters with wildlife like bears, wolves, and cougars are possible. Sudden weather changes can also be hazardous.
